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PREFACE

The *FY 07-12 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)* is northeastern Illinois' six-year agenda of surface transportation projects. The *TIP* lists projects for which federal money is sought and regionally significant, non-federally funded projects planned for implementation in the next six years.

The *TIP* is a tool for multi-jurisdictional communication and public information. It helps both the transportation community and the general public track the use of local, state and federal transportation funds. The *TIP* also facilitates a regional transportation needs assessment and decision-making process. Thus, the *TIP* assists MPO members, other transportation implementers, and planning organizations in establishing a transportation program that reflects the goals of the *2030 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP)*, the region's long-range transportation plan.

Chapter 1 contains a regional overview and a discussion of how the *TIP* supports the goals of the long-range plan. The goals of the *RTP* are listed in Chapter 1, which also includes the *TIP* program summary. Chapter 2 describes the agencies and steps in the *TIP* development process and describes the various funding sources for transportation projects. Chapter 3 discusses northeastern Illinois' fiscal plan for its transportation program. Chapter 4 provides an overview of the region's response to federal mandates. Chapter 5 explains how to read the *TIP* project listing. Non-federally funded regionally significant projects are listed in Appendix 4. Chapter 6 is a listing of the projects by that make up the FY 2007-2012 Program. Chapter 7 is a grouped listing of projects by project group and Chapter 8 is a grouped listing of projects by funding source. Additional non-federally funded regionally significant projects are listed in Appendix 4.
